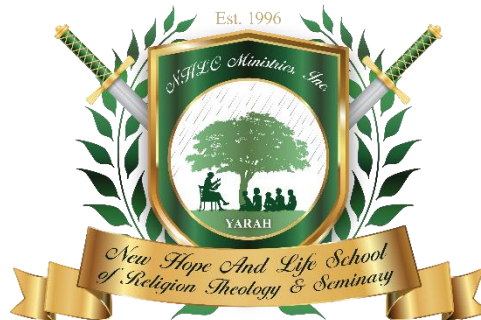

Submitting Assignments

How to submit your completed assignments:

1. All work should be typed on standard 8 ½ by 11 white paper, laser or ink jet paper.
2. All work must be submitted in a left had binder that securely holds the work.
3. Submit all original work. Copies will not be accepted.
4. Make certain that the first page of all submitted work is exactly as shown on the “Sample Cover Sheet” page within this book of instructions and guidelines.
5. All work must be typed and single spaced in the standard #12 font.
6. All margins must be 1 and 1 ½ inches on left, and one-inch top and one inch on right and bottom. Sloppy work (poor English, misspelled words, mark outs, x-outs, and correction fluid used) will affect your grade. Each page must be numbered at the bottom center of page, one half inch up.
7. DO NOT SUBMIT PARTIAL ASSIGNMENS:
8. All answers are to be completed as follows:
 - A. Type the question single spaced.
 - B. Skip a line then types your answer single spaced.
 - C. Check your work carefully before you submit assignments, because errors will affect your grade.
9. If you need assistance or have questions, place your questions with all references on a separate piece of paper as the last page of the assignment. Never ask questions in your answer.
10. We will accept your assignments by mail; however, assignments must arrive on the scheduled due date.
11. When asked to “give the scripture” we want the entire verse and location. When asked to give “the scripture reference” we only want the location, such as “Romans 6:23.” Please refer in your footnotes.
12. Do not send payments with assignments.
13. If we do not receive written communication from you within one semester or 90 days, you will be considered inactive, and there is a charge to be reactivated in your program of studies.

SAMPLE ANSWER:

1. Tell us what Dr. Charles Braden must say regarding the term “Cult.” What does the author add to this statement?

ANSWER: He defines it as any religious group, which differs significantly in one or more respects as to belief or practice from those religious groups, which are regarded as the normative expressions of religion in our total culture.

The author adds, “That a cult might be defined as a group of people gathered about a specific person or person’s misinterpretation of the Bible.”

Status Reports

Records of progress known as status reports are maintained by each instructor in the student's academic file. These status reports are used by instructors and faculty members to communicate with each student as to their grades, progress, and further education. Upon completion of each course, students receive an official grade report.

Ministry And Life Experience Credit

New Hope And Life School of Religion Theology & Seminary, aka NHL Christian Leadership Institute may grant ministry and life experience credits to students, but within the guidelines of established policy. Life experience credit is granted upon evaluation by the office of academic affairs.

For Life Experience credits, we request a portfolio, collect all material that proves your experience. Materials will vary depending on what your experience has been but will include any documents that demonstrate your knowledge and skills. Possible materials may include:

- resumes
- work samples
- awards you have received
- references of people who are familiar with your work
- multimedia (photographs, videos, etc.)
- certificates
- newspaper / magazine clippings
- ministry experience.

Organize and present your portfolio in a concise, convincing manner. Make sure that your message comes across in the way your work is organized. Provide a list of included documents and the respective skills and knowledge that they prove, as well as suggested course equivalency, may help reviewers to understand your experience and target credits to specific courses.

Applying for life experience credits and organizing a portfolio may take quite a bit of time. But, when you compare it to the time you would have spent in class learning material that you've already mastered, you'll be glad you took a few extra hours to get credit for what you already know.

ACADEMIC HONORS

Graduation Honors: All credits hours with a passing grade are awarded quality points based on the level achieved. The student must meet the following GPA standards to receive the special honors listed below:

Graduation honors will be noted on the official transcript.

Withdrawal and Inactive Students
